Possible weekly topics for the month of July and first week in August include:


Fun with Fleece

Learn all about fiber animals and how to prepare fleece. Make a Cold/Hot Pad, Dryer Balls, felt flowers, and some fiber art.



Horses, Horses

Make a stable for a model horse and all its accessories! Learn how to groom, saddle and bridle a real horse! (Riding lessons are optional and a separate fee.)



Farmhouse Baking

Learn to make tarts, cookies, jelly and teas using berries and herbs grown on the farm.



The Mouse House

Design a house for a mouse. Learn to make miniature furniture. Make a family of needle felted mice using wool from our sheep.



Art in the Garden

Create works of art that are farm and garden related. Projects include: suncatchers, spinners, and cement leaves.



<u>The Succulent Desert Garden</u> Learn about succulents. Design a garden using broken pots.

Make garden accessories using polymer clay.

Make a personalized serving tray. Learn about food pairings. Bake some pastries! Make some cheese!
